

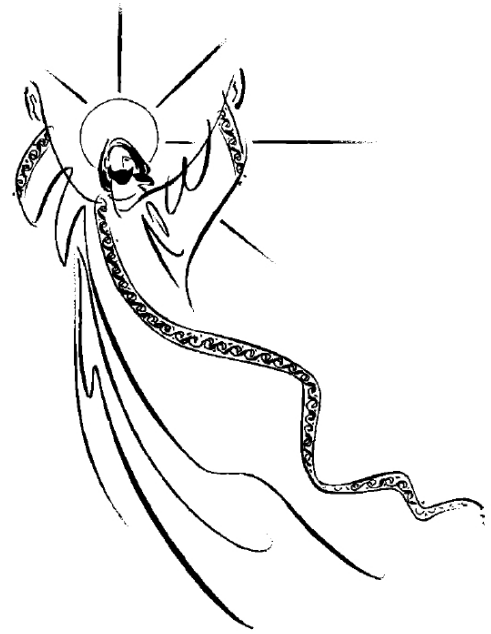

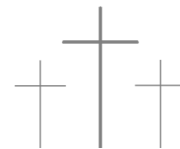


**“Fathers’ Day”

### The Ascension of Jesus Christ is meaningful for several reasons:

#### ASCENSION



1) It signaled the end of His earthly ministry. God the Father had lovingly sent His Son into the world at Bethlehem, and now the Son was returning to the Father. The period of human limitation was at an end.

2) It signified success in His earthly work. All that He had come to do, He had accomplished.

3) It marked the return of His heavenly glory. Jesus' glory had been veiled during His sojourn on earth, with one brief exception at the Transfiguration.

4) It symbolized His exaltation by the Father. The One with whom the Father is well pleased was received up in honor and given a name above all names.

5) It allowed Him to prepare a place for us.

6) It indicated the beginning of His new work as High Priest and Mediator of the New Covenant.

7) It set the pattern for His return. When Jesus comes to set up the Kingdom, He will return just as He left-literally, bodily, and visibly in the clouds

Currently, the Lord Jesus is in heaven. The Scriptures frequently picture Him at the right hand of the Father—a position of honor and authority. Christ is the Head of the Church, the giver of spiritual gifts.

### 30 MAGGIO 2019 - GIOVEDÌ L'ASCENSIONE DEL SIGNORE

Con la solennità dell'Ascensione di Gesù al Cielo si conclude la vita terrena di Gesù che con il suo corpo, alla presenza degli apostoli, si unisce fisicamente al Padre, per non comparire più sulla Terra fino alla sua Seconda venuta (**Parusia**) per il Giudizio finale. Questa festività è molto antica e viene attestata già a partire **dal IV secolo**. Per la Chiesa cattolica e le Chiese protestanti, l'Ascensione si colloca di norma 40 giorni dopo la Pasqua, cioè il giovedì della sesta settimana del Tempo pasquale, ovvero quello successivo alla VI domenica di Pasqua. Nel **Credo degli Apostoli** viene menzionata con queste parole: «Gesù è salito al cielo, siede alla destra del Padre. E di nuovo verrà, nella gloria, per giudicare i vivi e i morti, e il suo regno non avrà fine».

San Giovanni nel quarto Vangelo, pone il trionfo di Cristo nella sua completezza nella Resurrezione, e del resto anche gli altri evangelisti dando scarso rilievo all'Ascensione, confermano che la vera ascensione, cioè la trasfigurazione e il passaggio di Gesù nel mondo della gloria, sia avvenuta il mattino di Pasqua, evento sfuggito ad ogni esperienza e fuori da ogni umano controllo. Quindi correggendo una mentalità sufficientemente diffusa, i testi evangelici invitano a collocare l'ascensione e l'intronizzazione di Gesù alla destra del Padre, nello stesso giorno della sua morte, egli è tornato poi dal Cielo per manifestarsi ai suoi e completare la sua predicazione per un periodo di 'quaranta' giorni. Quindi l'Ascensione raccontata da Luca, Marco e dagli Atti degli Apostoli, non si riferisce al primo ingresso del Salvatore nella gloria, quanto piuttosto l'ultima apparizione e partenza che chiude le sue manifestazioni visibili sulla terra. Pertanto l'intento dei racconti dell'Ascensione non è quello di descrivere il reale ritorno al Padre, ma di far conoscere alcuni tratti dell'ultima manifestazione di Gesù, una manifestazione di congedo, necessaria perché Egli deve ritornare al Padre per completare tutta la Redenzione: "Se non vado non verrà a voi il Consolatore, se invece vado ve lo manderò" (Giov. 16, 5-7). Il catechismo della Chiesa Cattolica dà all'Ascensione questa definizione: "Dopo quaranta giorni da quando si era mostrato agli Apostoli sotto i tratti di un'umanità ordinaria, che velavano la sua gloria di Risorto, Cristo sale al cielo e siede alla destra del Padre. Egli è il Signore, che regna ormai con la sua umanità nella gloria eterna di Figlio di Dio e intercede incessantemente in nostro favore presso il Padre. Ci manda il suo Spirito e ci dà la speranza di raggiungerlo un giorno, avendoci preparato un posto".
